## **Guidance - EO 72 and 79 Updates**

Effective May 15, Governor Northam amended Executive Order 72 to align with CDC's Updated Guidelines for Fully Vaccinated People, which recommends that anyone who is fully vaccinated can participate in indoor and outdoor activities without wearing a mask. Exceptions include K-12 public and private schools, public transit, healthcare facilities, homeless shelters, and correctional facilities.

- Per EO 72, employees who work in certain business sectors—including restaurants, retail, fitness, personal care, and entertainment—must continue to wear masks unless fully vaccinated, consistent with CDC guidelines
- Individuals who are fully vaccinated may also continue to wear masks if they choose to do so
- All business and gathering restrictions will be lifted when <a href="Executive Order 79">Executive Order 79</a> takes effect early morning Friday May 28 (prior to Mem Day weekend)- this is earlier than originally planned for June 15.
- In order to protect themselves and others, unvaccinated people should continue to mask and remain physically distanced in most settings
